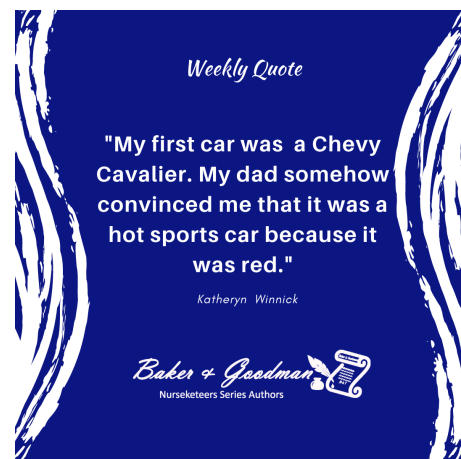

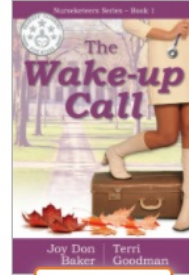
First Car
