Author Insight

Anticipating change and exploring techniques to adapt before unexpected events can interfere with the current reality helps us weather change without resentment or disappointment.

Life events might prevent one partner from completing the project or from continuing at the same level of participation.

Considering such possibilities early in the partnership, and making provisions in the contract for managing change can prevent confusion and discord. Negotiating the contract details can be an intense experience for the partners as the process forces them to step back and consider the implications of their decisions and to find shared meaning in their relationship in anticipation of a new and fulfilling interaction.



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
